



FPM Foundation Cash Scholarship Award

The FPM Foundation Cash Scholarship Awards are one time cash scholarship in varying amounts from a minimum of \$2,000, designed to help students offset the soaring cost of an aviation degree. The cash will be distributed in the form of a check made out to the recipient and the recipient's college, university or technical school at the award presentation of the FPMF Golf Classic in late August.

FPMF Cash Scholarship Application Requirements are as Follows:

1. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen
2. Applicant must be a college sophomore, junior or senior currently enrolled in a two or four-year aviation flight program with plans to complete a curriculum leading to a degree and a career in the aviation industry.
3. Applicant must have a 3.25 minimum GPA (on a 4.0 system) at the time of application
4. The completed application shall be accompanied by the following items:
 - A letter of recommendation from a member of the Aviation Department Faculty at the institution in which the applicant is currently enrolled
 - A current resume
 - Official transcripts from current and all prior collegiate institutions
 - A 250-word essay describing the applicant's aviation background, current status and future aviation goals
 - Photocopies of all FAA ratings/certificates held
