



## FPMF On-Line Crew Resource Management

### Maintenance Scholarship Award

This one day Maintenance Training course, donated by **FlightSafety International**, is an instructor led, interactive, web based course that the recipient can take from the comfort of their own home. The course is oriented towards the human factors involved with running a safe & efficient maintenance facility.

Recipients are responsible for supplying their own computer but a small cash stipend donated by the FPM Foundation may be available to help defray a portion of upgrade costs for the recipient's computer if their current system is not compatible with the program requirements.

Approximately retail value of the course is \$3,150.

#### **FPMF Online Maintenance Training Scholarship Applicant Requirements are as Follows:**

1. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
2. Applicant must be currently enrolled in their final year of a two or four-year aviation maintenance program with plans to complete a curriculum leading to a career in aviation maintenance, or have finished such a program within the past six months.
3. Applicant must have a 3.25 minimum GPA (on a 4.0 system) at the time of application.
4. The completed application shall be accompanied by the following items:
  - A letter of recommendation from a member of the Aviation Department Faculty at the institution from which the applicant recently graduated or is currently enrolled
  - A current Resume
  - Official transcripts from current and all prior collegiate institutions
  - A 250-word essay describing the applicant's aviation background, current status and future aviation goals
  - Photocopies of all FAA ratings/certificates held
5. Recipient of the award must complete the training program within one year of receipt of the scholarship
