



FPM FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Scholarship applicants will be interviewed by representatives of the FPM Foundation in late May or early June at ADI or the applicant's school. Announcement of scholarship awards will be made shortly thereafter and presentation of the awards will be made at the annual FPM Foundation Golf Outing and Fundraiser on the third Friday of August at the Bay Pointe Golf Club in West Bloomfield, Michigan.

Recipient participation is requested but not required.

Candidate Requirements are as follows:

1. Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen.
2. Applicant must be a college sophomore, junior or senior, (depending upon the award they are seeking) currently enrolled in a two or four-year Aviation Flight, Maintenance or Management curriculum with plans to earn a degree leading to a career in the field of aviation.
3. Applicant must have achieved a minimum grade point average of **3.25** (on a 4.0 system) at the time of application.
4. The completed application shall be accompanied by the following items:
 - a. A letter of recommendation from a member of the Aviation Department Faculty at the institution in which the applicant is currently enrolled.
 - b. A current resume.
 - c. Official transcripts from applicant's current and prior colleges or universities.
 - d. A 250 word essay describing the applicant's aviation background, current aviation status and future aviation goals.
 - e. Photocopies of all FAA ratings / certificates held. (If applicable)
5. Completed application package must be postmarked no later than midnight on the **Last Friday in March** to be eligible for a scholarship.
6. Checks will be made payable directly to the recipient's school in the name of the recipient.
7. Previous recipients are not eligible.
